**Levels of accountability of a Candidate seeking to become
the Commander-in-Chief of the United States of America**

Candidates to the Presidency are held to differing standards of expectation in terms of their knowledge of military protocols and culture. For example, it would have been unreasonable to hold Senator Barack Obama or Senator Hillary Clinton as candidates to the same standards as one would hold candidates George H. W. Bush or John F. Kennedy. Neither Senator Obama nor Senator Clinton served in the military so some leeway is appropriate, even though they would still be expected to learn the military culture as part of the preparation for their job aspirations.

The fact that Donald Trump attended high-school at the New York Military Academy is highly relevant. Known for its strict disciplinary code and a full-immersion into a military culture, young Donald Trump *was heavily indoctrinated in the nuances of military protocol*. His *education and life experiences during his formative years* included training related to the chain of command, marching, formations, insignias, ranks and military discipline. In effect, Mr. Trump **rose through the chain of command**, received various medals and **graduated with the rank of Captain**. His *military education creates the highest level of expectation and accountability* regarding the military culture. **For this reason, Candidate Trump never should have permitted, much less approved, the inclusion of an *unregulated militia* or *vigilante soldier* in a glorified context for his TV spot. It’s either a failure to lead or complicity with the message.** The most likely but troubling option is that he couldn’t avoid noticing the lack of insignias on the soldier and either failed to have his team replace the shot or he was convinced that it was appropriate as *campaign strategy*. Either option would have negated everything Trump *learned and lived* at the Academy. By endorsing the *vigilante concept*, Mr. Trump and the team that *designed* this spot became accomplices of *vigilante lethal actions* on the border, which in legal terms amounts to *aiding and abetting domestic terrorism*. Trump had to know that endorsing this shot was a serious decision. His reference to “the Second Amendment people” on August 9, 2016 proves he knew about the *type of people* his political playbook and *fascist style* was attracting. Either way, Trump is accountable for the content of the spot which ends with: “I’m Donald Trump, and I approve this message.”
