INTERVIEW WITH MEXICAN NATIONAL FRANCISCO BUSTILLOS ALAMOS
WITNESS OF VIGILANTE DOMESTIC TERRORISM ON US SOIL - SURVIVOR 1

In January of 2019, Francisco Bustillos Alamos, a Mexican national from Durango testified via videotaped interview in Tijuana, México that on August 20th of 2018 he witnessed acts of domestic terrorism after crossing the border from Tecate when 3 men on horseback dressed as soldiers intercepted his group. Two of the men began to get whipped with lassos by the soldiers. Francisco ran back towards Mexico with two women in the group fearing for their safety. He stated that 4-5 hours later, the two men also returned but were bloodied and lacerated, stating that they had been warned by the soldiers that “the next time they were going to be killed.” One man had an open wound on his head and a black eye. The other had lacerations on his legs and back. Francisco described the soldiers as dressed in camouflage, armed with rifles but that they weren’t soldiers because they were out of shape, and that they seemed like ranch owners. He testified that a woman from Michoacán had been sexually assaulted while crossing. She had been mutilated in her vaginal area, was tied with a rope and her breasts had scars from the men’s bite marks. Her relatives came to pick her up, she was about 22 years old. He also described another woman who was beaten and raped as the men would mock her telling her that “this is the only thing that Mexican women are good for.” He stated that in Arizona there are many Americans trying to kill Mexicans. Francisco works as a car painter, his wife is a US Citizen. His son is a US Citizen who works in the FBI and another son in the US NAVY, also a USC. His testimony would be corroborated if Congress would subpoena the medical files of the woman in Michoacán that he witnessed had been tortured and mutilated. Her reconstructive surgeries and bite marks on her breasts could ID the perpetrators if cross-referenced by law enforcement in the US. A call to victims and their families to come forward with their evidence in a confidential setting would also produce thousands of similar crime reports. The bodies Bustillos described would be located if law enforcement agencies with HRD (Human Remains Detection) K-9 units would be assigned to search the areas with the same levels of interest shown on searches for US citizens. Francisco stated that many immigrants choose to remain quiet about crimes they are victim of while crossing the border. Their testimony would be easily obtainable if Congress, politicians, State Attorney Generals or law enforcement agencies showed a humane level of interest in prosecuting the *Minutemen militias*.
