INTERVIEW WITH GUATEMALAN NATIONAL HARBERTH GODINEZ
WITNESS OF VIGILANTE DOMESTIC TERRORISM ON US SOIL - SURVIVOR 2

In Fall of 2018, paralegal assistant Harberth Godinez, a Guatemalan national living in Los Angeles since the age of 15 declared in a videotaped interview that when he was crossing the border he noticed a group of men near some tents close to the path they were following. Harberth was headed to be reunited with his parents who were already settled in the United States. He stated that they heard the men shouting at them in English, and then they started firing at them with rifles. Harberth and the members of his group ran for about 10 minutes to escape the gunmen. “What we see right now happening at the border with the extrajudicial killings, we don’t see the actual numbers of people that have been murdered. One of the reasons is that there is not too much focus, second, they are not interested in serving justice to people that according to them don’t belong in this country. That’s the reason why I believe that to them there is no reason to investigate these murders. There’s not a lot of focus on what’s happening on the border, whether is the killings, whether it’s the amount of people that die of natural causes, or the fact that these people are fleeing because of persecution, because of natural disasters. The way that they portray the stories, the way that they portray this issue is the amount of people coming to this country, they don’t focus on the reasons why they are coming to this country but they focus on how,” he declared.
