Military Protocol Analysis

1. Insignias: The clearest indicator that this is a *vigilante* or an *unregulated civilian militia* is the absence of any type of insignia designating country, rank or the branch in which the soldier serves. Assuming that this was a member of the military and that the *Posse Comitatus* statute wasn't in the Constitution, there would only be three possibilities: the US National Guard, the US Army (Green Berets or Delta Force) or the United States Marine Corps (USMC). The US NAVY is ruled out as the USS Iowa is shown later, which would cause a repeat mention on the NAVY. The US Coast Guard is ruled out for obvious reasons. The US Air Force or any Special Operations branch of the USAF or USMC might be a possibility, but in any they are also ruled out because of the absence of insignias.

2. Uniform: This is a Battle Dress Uniform (BDU) or “camo” available commercially at Military Surplus stores. The “boonie hat” confirms intercepted communications by private investigators of a “national call to arms” specifying that “*Special Ops*” and “*Sniper teams*” move to the border to *intercept* migrant caravans. These teams include active duty / retired military or law enforcement personnel. The soldier in Trump's TV ad is clearly an *unregulated militia* or *Minuteman vigilante*.
