***PROJECTING*
EXAMPLE 1: “TERRORISTS”**

One of the techniques perfected by Tom Tancredo and the movement he has organized over the past 2 decades has been the strategy of *projecting*, i.e. the blaming of others of doing precisely the things that his movement is guilty of doing. For example, the TV spot that was aired by the Trump campaign used the term “TERRORISTS” to describe Hispanic migrants. Even though there are crime statistics for immigrants that are almost identical if not slightly lower to those of US citizens, there have been no significant incidents of terrorism in the United States involving Hispanic / Latino or *Mesoamerican* migrants. The parties or persons that are involved in terrorism, however, are the armed *vigilantes* patrolling the border. Their activities fit the legal definition of what is recognized in courts as “*domestic terrorism.*” This is a very clear example of projecting criminal behavior onto those who are actually being victimized by their activities.

According to the US Legal website, domestic terrorism means “activities that--

(A) involve **acts dangerous to human life** that are a **violation of the criminal laws** of the United States or of any State;

(B) appear to be intended--

(i) **to intimidate or coerce a civilian population;**

(ii) to influence the policy of a government by intimidation or coercion; or

(iii) to affect the conduct of a government by mass destruction, assassination, or kidnapping;
and

(C) **occur primarily within the territorial jurisdiction of the United States.**”(18 USCS § 2331)
